
Alle studenter ved høyere utdanning bør ha praksis som læringsform



# DON'T THEY GET JOBS?


- Unemployment among people with higher education is 1%, 1,7% in the population total
- 9 out of 10 NTNU students have a job 6 months after graduation
- 86% say their education is relevant for the job they have





## WHAT IS THE PROBLEM?

- Dose the focus on work life relevance mean my subjects aren't good enough?
- Students want an answer to "what will I become?"
- Goal oriented, and stressed





## HOW CAN WE HELP?

NTNU Career shall contribute to enable students to make good career choices





## HOW DID WE GET STAFF TO LISTEN?

- Contacted study program leaders
- Talked about helping the students know what they have been learning
- Recognising that this may not be a quality problem
- Listening to what problems they experience when meeting students
