

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## Government investigation: A strategic agenda for internationalisation ( SOU 2018:3)

- ❖ "Mobility among Swedish students needs to increase, especially in areas where it is currently very low"
- ❖ **Suggestion:** at least **25 procent** of all students, by 2025, should have spent at least three months of their education abroad.



## Plint – Platform for internationalisation

Increased internationalisation in higher education, research and innovation strengthens Sweden as a knowledge-based nation and has great significance for competitiveness and prosperity.

Therefore, the government has given several Swedish authorities the task of forming a collaboration platform that, through cooperation and dialogue, will facilitate the work of higher education institutions in internationalisation.

### Three areas of cooperation:

- ❖ Mobility for students, researchers and staff;
- ❖ Sweden as a knowledge-based nation
- ❖ Responsible internationalisation

# Plint – current ongoing work

## Issues of concern:

- No coordination, just support...
- Relationship between internationalisation and geopolitical tensions
- Migration versus international students and researchers
- Difficulty to open bank accounts

## Concrete results so far

- Networks, contact routes - effective communication
- Mapping of new forms of mobility to ensure that regulations are up to date with the developments
- Make visible good examples of mobility within professional educations
- Survey of available funding opportunities – identify gaps




# Academia study visits and Cross-border seminars
